Dear Parent/Guardian:

As you know, we are about to begin the programming process for the 2010-2011 school year. This most important process requires many steps to make sure the appropriate courses are selected. This necessitates several counselor and student meetings to communicate the necessary programming information.

This year's programming process will include the following elements:
